Saint Francis is the home of the Hoffman Heart Institute of Connecticut, the first comprehensive heart institute in southern New England. More open-heart surgeries are performed at Saint Francis than at any other hospital in Connecticut. Among the therapies pioneered by physicians at the Hoffman Heart Institute is the implantation of a new type of pacemaker for patients suffering from congestive heart failure as well as disruptions in their heart's electrical systems.

Hoffman Heart physicians have also pioneered port access heart surgery. The minimally invasive procedure eliminates the need to separate the breastbone to reach the heart, one of the most traumatic aspects of conventional heart surgery. Saint Francis is the only hospital in the state performing this procedure

Saint Francis is equally dedicated to the diagnosis and treatment of cancer. The detection of so-called clinically silent breast cancers is enhanced through computer aided detection (CAD) technology at the Saint Francis Comprehensive Breast Health Center. Purchased through the hospital's Women's Auxiliary, Saint Francis was first in the state with this technology. nology that digitally scans mammograms for cancers not immediately detectable through traditional visual examination. Clinical studies have demonstrated that CAD can improve the detection of breast cancers in mammograms by as much as 20 percent. The Saint Francis/Mount Sinai Regional Cancer Center also was the first in Connecticut to acquire AcQSIM*, an advanced simulator that allows physicians to more quickly and precisely plan and deliver radiation treatments for certain cancers.

The family-style ambience of each program is designed to nurture self-esteem and promote healthy normalization through caring relationships. Along with school and formal therapies, residents learn to work and to develop positive values through performing basic tasks such as gardening, care of animals and cooking. The daily living experience of relationships within the milieu gives both immediacy and depth to treatment interventions. Active participation by the residents in the life of each community fosters the development of responsibility and bendership skills. sibility and leadership skills.
Wellspring's therapeutic programs are comprehensive and intensive, supported by medical

supervision and nursing presence. Individual, family, group, emotional-expressive and creative-expressive modalities are coordinated to address issues in a concerted way.

Specialized tracks for eating disorder, severe attachment difficulties and substance abuse are provided within the general program. Our state-approved therapeutic special education school serves the residential programs and surrounding communities.
