



Building treatment plans around the twelve-step programs outlined by Alcoholics Anonymous and Narcotics Anonymous, staff at Arms Acres and Conifer Park work with patients to identify triggers for abuse and methods to promote sobriety. Together, counselor and client create a personalized treatment plan and an individualized approach to aftercare planning.

There is a dedicated Women's unit at both facilities, where female clients are encouraged to explore recovery strategies related to issues including depression, parenting, codependency, anger, anxiety, loss and trauma.

The Waismann Method

Opiate pain medications like Vicodin and Oxycontin are commonly prescribed and often cause physical dependency. Until now, treatments for opiate dependence have been unsuccessful and unpleasant. But now, because of increased understanding of the illness. patients no longer need to rely on these painful and ineffective methods. By medically inducing detoxification while the patient is under anesthesia, doctors are able to reverse opiate dependency with The Waismann Method in a safe and humane manner.
